Primary Purpose -

Prepare and serve soup, salad, sandwiches, prepare foods, alcoholic and non-alcoholic beverages from a free-standing snack bar on the golf course.

Essential Functions -

- 1. Maintain cleanliness and organization of all Halfway House storage and service areas.
- 2. Serve food and beverages to members in an efficient manner.
- 3. Set up and stock work area with food and beverage supplies on a daily basis.
- 4. Establish, maintain and seasonally reset par stocks for consumable goods.
- 5. Offer product suggestions to increase sales and heighten member satisfaction.
- 6. Maintain a clean, safe, organized work area.
- 7. Ensure perishable foods are held at safe storage temperatures.
- 8. Unsure food and beverage products are rotated to optimize freshness.
- 9. Process member billing; complete POS daily closeout instructions.
- 10. Assemble sandwiches to order while golfers wait "on the turn".
- 11. Cook and serve hot dogs, brats and other menu items without main kitchen support.
- 12. Perform other duties as assigned.

Required Qualifications:

- High School Diploma or General Education Degree (GED); or one to three months related experience and/or training; or equivalent combination of education and experience.
- Food Handlers Card
- Present a positive, professional image.
- Must be self-motivated and customer service oriented.
- Strong interpersonal as well as written and oral communication skills.
- Reliable and predictable attendance.
- Ability to develop and maintain awareness of occupational hazards and safety precautions; skilled in following safety practices and recognizing hazards.

Physical Demands & Work Environment -

- Position is in busy, non-smoking restaurant in a private residential community in N. Scottsdale.
- Must be able to frequently sit, stand, bend, use hands to finger, handle, or feel; and talk or hear, stoop, kneel, crouch, close vision, distance vision, color vision, peripheral vision, depth vision, ability to adjust focus, crawl, and walk.
- Ability to lift up to 50 lbs., and to lift overhead and push/pull, move lighter objects.
