Betsy King, LPGA Hall of Fame golfer and 2007 Solheim Cup Captain, founded **Golf Fore Africa** after seeing first hand the hidden faces of AIDS and the terrible plight of AIDS orphans in Africa in 2006. Working with **World Vision** (www.worldvision.org) and the LPGA, she started a campaign to raise \$250,000 to support an initial project in Mudusomwa, Rwanda. In October 2007, Betsy, along with five other LPGA Golfers—Juli Inkster, Reilley Rankin, Wendy Posillico, Renee Powell, and Katherine Hull—traveled to Rwanda.

Bringing Hope to Children and Families in Mudusomwa, Rwanda!

Families in this community struggle every day with the hopelessness of poverty. In Mudusomwa, 75% live below the poverty line. A lack of schools, access to healthcare, malnutrition, and the legacy of warfare and genocide make life in Mudusomwa a daily challenge. When the impact of AIDS is added, households are stretched to the breaking point when relatives or neighbors take in orphaned children.

How do we meet such an overwhelming need? One child—and one community at a time

Golf Fore Africa, LPGA Players and **World Vision** are bringing help and hope through a community-based approach to providing Mudusomwa with the resources they need to develop sustainable solutions for their community.
